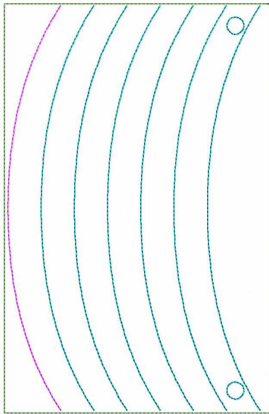
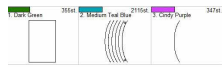

- MEDIUM TEAR AWAY STABILIZER
- SCOTCH TAPE
- COTTON WOVEN FABRIC REMNANTS
- INSUL-BRITE (COTTON QUILT BATTIG WORKS TOO)
- IRONING BOARD FABRIC (AVAILABLE AT CRAFT STORES BY THE YARD)
- 3/8" - 1/2" WIDE COTTON TWILL TAPE
- IRON
- FUSIBLE DOUBLE SIDED 1/2" SEAM TAPE

IF YOU ARE MAKING THE
POTHOLDER, LOAD PART 1

STITCH THE DIE LINE ON
A NEW PIECE OF MEDIUM WEIGHT
TEAR AWAY STABILIZER



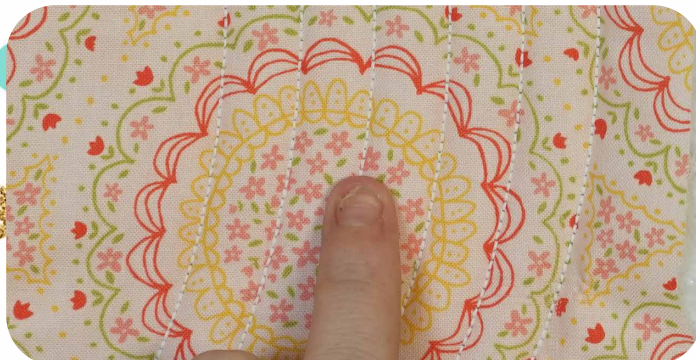
CUT 2 PIECES OF
OUTTER FABRIC, 2 PIECES OF
LINER FABRIC AND 2 PIECES
OF INSUL-BRITE MATERIAL TO
COVER THE RECTANGLE DIE BOX
GENEROUSLY.



PLACE ONE PIECE OF INSUL-
BRITE AND ONE PIECE OF OUTER
FABRIC OVER THE BOX RIGHT SIDE
UP SO IT OVERLAPS THE EDGES
EVENLY



STITCH THE ALIGNMENT
CIRCLES AND THE QUILTING
LINES.



IN THE HOOP OWL POTHOLDER



PLACE ONE PIECE OF LINER
FABRIC RIGHT SIDE DOWN OVER THE
DIE BOX.



STITCH THE FINAL TACK
DOWN LINE.



REMOVE THE FABRIC PANEL
FROM THE STABILIZER



WITH PINKING SHEARS OR
SCISSORS TRIM ABOUT 1/8" FROM
THE FINAL TACK DOWN LINE ALONG
THE CURVED EDGE.



TURN THE PANEL RIGHT
SIDE OUT AS SHOWN.

IN THE HOOP OWL POT HOLDER



IT SHOULD LOOK LIKE THIS.



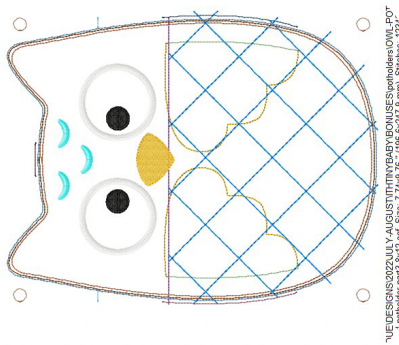
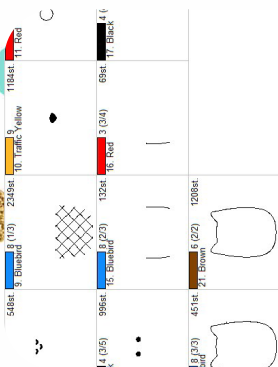
IRON THE SEAM EDGE SO IT LAYS FLAT.



SPRAY SOME TEMPORARY SPRAY ADHESIVE ON THE INSUL-BRITE LAYER INSIDE AND SMOOTH THE LINER FABRIC TO IT SO IT DOESNT SHIFT AROUND.

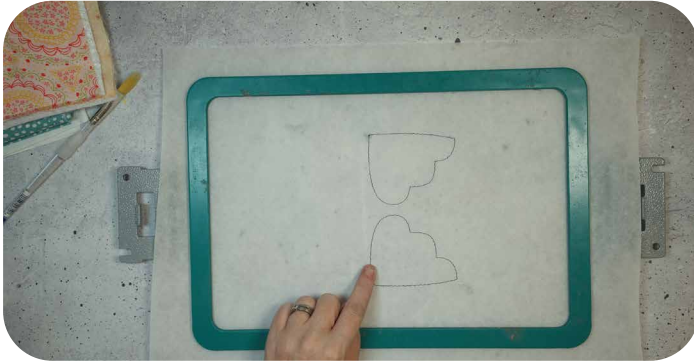


LOAD PART 2 AND CREATE THE OTHER FLAP SO YOU NOW HAVE TWO LIKE THIS. THE MUG RUG WILL NOT HAVE THESE PARTS.



LOAD PART 3 FOR THE POTHOLDER OR PART 1 FOR THE MUG RUG.

IN THE HOOP OWL POTHOLDER



STITCH THE DIE LINE FOR
THE WINGS (OPTIONAL)



COVER WITH 2 PIECES OF
FABRIC RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER.
(OPTIONAL)



STITCH THE TACKDOWN
FOR THE WINGS (OPTIONAL)



GENTLY PEEL UP THE
FABRIC FROM THE STABILIZER ON
THE TACK DOWN LINES. TRY TO
LEAVE THE STABILIZER INTACT.



THE WINGS SHOULD NOW
BE FREE FROM THE STABILIZER

IN THE HOOP ACORN POTHOLDER



TAPE OVER THE WING TACK
DOWN LINES ON THE STABILIZER
(OR USE A SCRAP OF STABILIZER
TAPED OVER THEM IF IT TORE)
THEN STITCH THE DIE LINE FOR THE
OWL



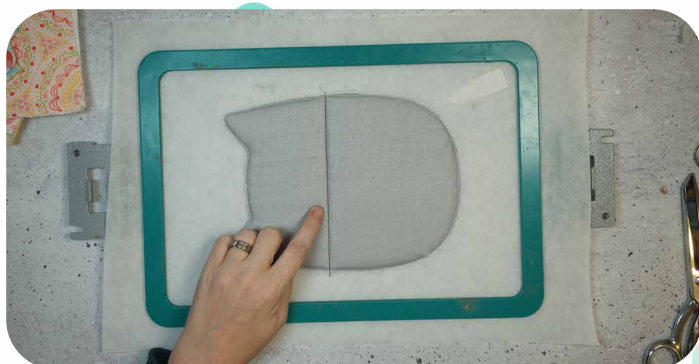
CUT 1 PIECE OF INSUL-
BRITE, 1 PIECE OF IRON BOARD
FABRIC TO GENEROUSLY COVER THE
OWL DIE LINE. SKIP THE IRONING
BOARD FABRIC FOR THE MUG
RUG.



STITCH THE TACK DOWN
LINE.



TRIM THE FABRIC LIKE AN
APPLIQUE CLOSE TO THE TACK
DOWN LINE.



STITCH THE DIE LINE.

IN THE HOOP OWL POTHOLDER



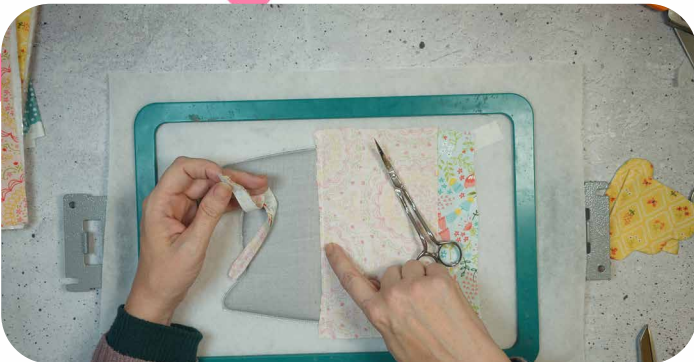
CUT ONE PIECE OF FABRIC TO COVER ABOVE THE LINE AND ONE PIECE TO COVER BELOW THE LINE. THESE FABRICS SHOULD BE GENEROUS.



PLACE THEM RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER SO THEY OVERLAP THE LINE BY 1/2"



STITCH THE TACK DOWN LINE



TRIM THE FABRIC ABOUT 1/8" FROM THE TACK DOWN LINE

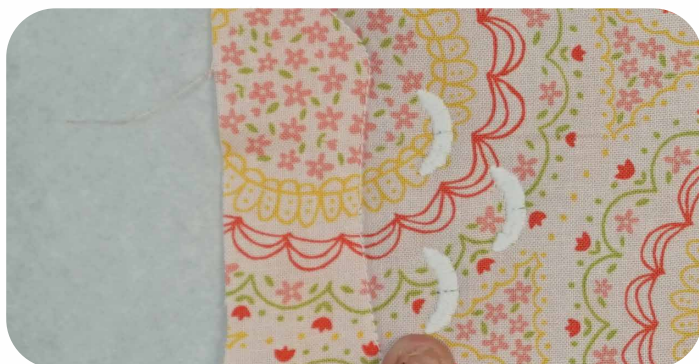


UNFOLD THE FABRIC LIKE A BOOK AND TAPE IN PLACE. YOU CAN USE TEMP SPRAY ADHESIVE TO HELP SMOOTH IT OUT IF DESIRED.

IN THE HOOP OWL POT HOLDER



STITCH THE TACK DOWN
LINE AND ALIGNMENT CIRCLES.
(THE ALIGNMENT CIRCLES WILL
ONLY STITCH FOR THE POTHOLDER
VERSION)



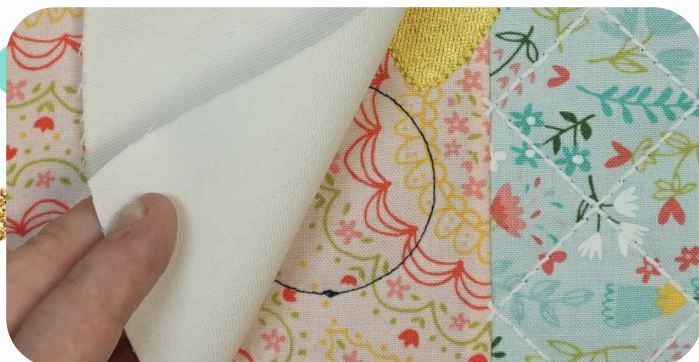
STITCH THE FEATHERS AT
THE TOP OF THE HEAD.



STITCH THE QUILTING.

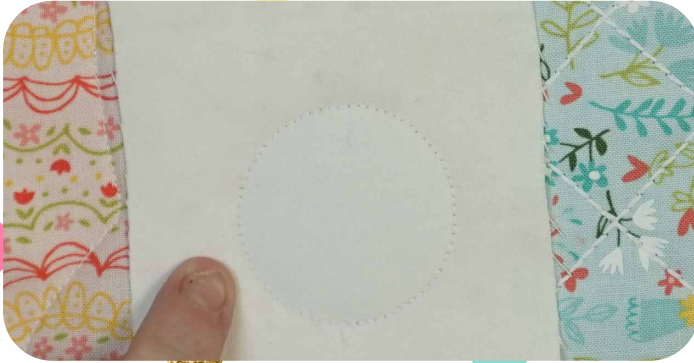


STITCH THE DIE LINE FOR
THE EYES.



COVER WITH FABRIC RIGH
SIDE UP AND TAPE IN PLACE.

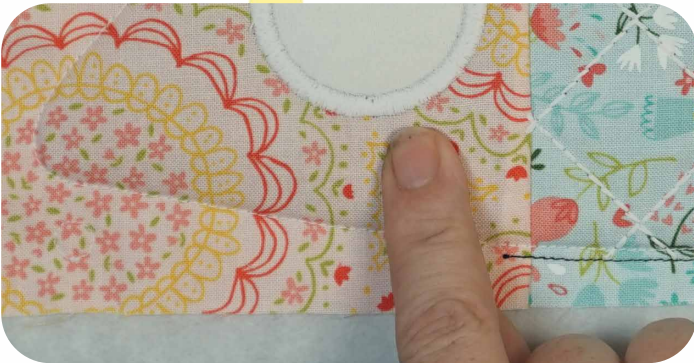
IN THE HOOP OWL POTHOLDER



STITCH THE EYE TACK
DOWN LINES.



TRIM AROUND THE EYE
TACK DOWN LINES AS YOU WOULD
FOR APPLIQUE.



STITCH THE SATIN STITCH
FOR THE EYES.



STITCH THE PUPILS.



STITCH THE DIE LINES FOR
THE WINGS.

IN THE HOOP OWL POT HOLDER



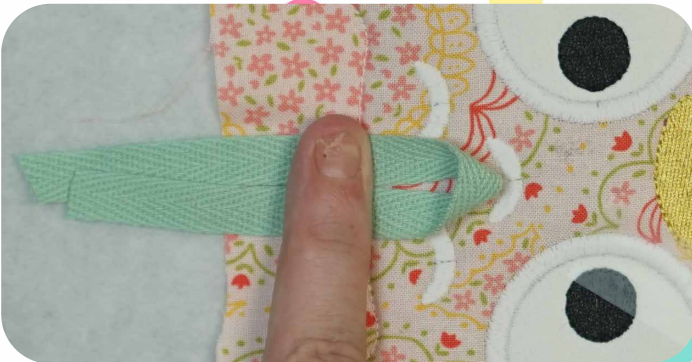
PLACE EACH WING OVER
THE WING DIE LINES AND TAPE IN
PLACE.



STITCH THE TACK DOWN
FOR THE WINGS.



STITCH THE DIE LINE
FOR THE TWILL TAPE/RIBBON
HANGER



CUT A 5" LENGTH OF
COTTON TWILL TAPE. ON SMALLER
PROJECTS USE 3/8" AND ON LARGER
USE 1/2" OR 3/4" WIDTH. FOLD THE
TWILL TAPE AS SHOWN TO CREATE A
LOOP.



TAPE IN PLACE AND STITCH
THE TACK DOWN LINE.

IN THE HOOP OWL POTHOLDER



FOR THE POTHOLDER ONLY,
LOCATE THE TWO TWIN QUILTED
PANELS WE MADE IN PARTS 1 AND
2. WE WILL PLACE THESE QUILTED
SIDE DOWN OVER OUR OWL.



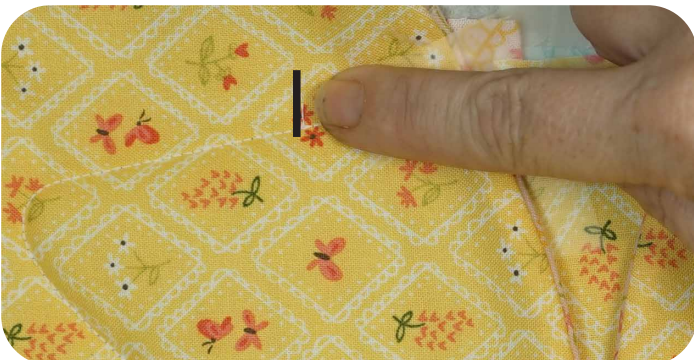
TAKE TIME TO ALIGN THE
CIRCLES FROM EACH PANEL TO THE
CIRCLES ON THE OWL



TAPE THEM IN PLACE AS
YOU GET THEM ALIGNED. IT SHOULD
LOOK LIKE THIS.



STITCH A TACK DOWN
LINE TO SECURE. THIS IS FOR THE
POTHOLDER ONLY.



THESE SMALL LINES WILL
ALSO STITCH ON THE POTHOLDER.
THEY ARE NEAR THE TOP OF THE
HEAD. IF MAKING THE MUG RUG
YOU WILL NEED TO STITCH THESE
NEXT.

IN THE HOOP ACORN POTHOLDER



CUT ONE PIECE OF LINER FABRIC THAT WILL COVER THE OWL FROM THE MARKS UPWARD, AND ANOTHER SMALLER FOR THE LOWER HALF BELOW THE MARKS. THEY SHOULD BE GENEROUS ALLOWING ROOM FOR MARGIN.



ON THE LARGER PIECE, TURN ONE OF THE EDGES UNDER AND IRON IT 1/2" AS SHOWN.



NOW WE SHOULD HAVE ONE LARGER PIECE OF LINER WITH THE EDGE IRONED UNDER, AND THEN THE SMALLER PIECE OF LINER.

IN THE HOOP ACORN POTHOLDER



PLACE THE LINER PIECE WITH THE FOLDED EDGE RIGHT SIDE DOWN SO THE FOLD TOUCHES THE TWO MARKS LIKE THIS.



TAKE THE SMALLER LINER FABRIC AND PLACE IT RIGHT SIDE DOWN SO IT OVERLAPS THE FOLDED EDGE BY 1/2" AS SHOWN.



TAPE THE LINER FABRICS IN PLACE.



STITCH THE FINAL TACK DOWN LINE. REMOVE THE POTHOLDER/MUGRUG FROM THE HOOP. REMOVE ALL OF THE STABILIZER FROM THE BACK.

IN THE HOOP OWL POT HOLDER



TRIM AROUND THE
POTHOLDER/MUGRUG ABOUT 1/8"-
1/4" FROM THE FINAL TACK DOWN
LINE.



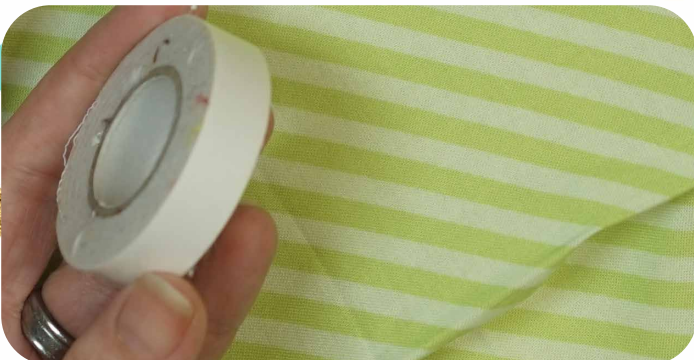
LOCATE THE FLAP ON THE
LINER FABRIC SIDE. YOU WILL TURN
THE OWL RIGHT SIDE OUT THROUGH
THIS OPENING.



IF YOU HAVE THE
POTHOLDER VERSION THEN THE
BACKSIDE WILL LOOK LIKE THIS. ON
THE MUG RUG, THE BACKSIDE WILL
JUST BE THE LINER FABRIC BUT IT
WILL BE RIGHT SIDE OUT.



WE NEED TO CLOSE UP THE
OPENING IN THE LINER.



I LIKE TO USE DOUBLE
FUSIBLE TAPE. IT IS 1/2" WIDE.

IN THE HOOP OWL POTHOLDER



I CUT A PIECE ABOUT AN INCH SHORTER THAN THE OPENING.



REACH INSIDE AND FIND THE FOLDED EDGE. PULL IT OUT TO EXPOSE IT. STICK THE FUSIBLE SEAM TAPE TO THE FOLDED FLAP LIKE THIS.



PEEL OFF THE PAPER BACKING TO EXPOSE THE OTHER TACK SIDE.



STICK IT TO THE OTHER HALF OF THE LINER FABRIC THAT IS SMALLER AND HAS THE RAW EDGE. IF YOUR SEAM TAPE REQUIRES, THEN IRON IT TO FUSE IT PERMANENTLY.

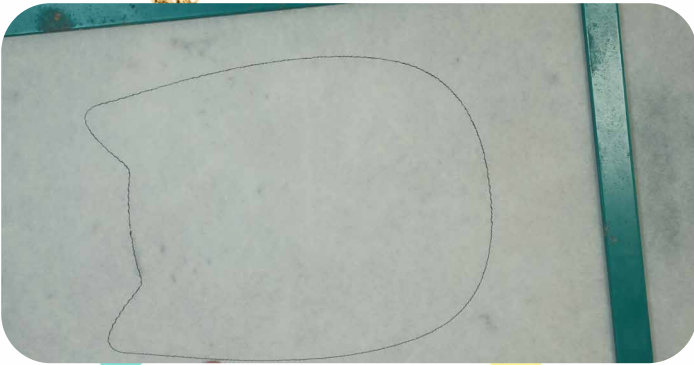


FOR THE POTHOLDER, WE WILL HAVE TO TURN THE OWL RIGHT SIDE OUT ONE MORE TIME. TO THIS POINT OUR QUILTED PANELS ON THE BACKSIDE HAVE BEEN LINER SIDE OUT. TURN THE QUILTED PANELS TO THE OTHER SIDE OF THE OWL ONE AT A TIME.

IN THE HOOP OWL POT HOLDER



THE FRONT OF THE OWL SHOULD NOW LOOK LIKE THIS.



LOAD PART 4. THIS IS OPTIONAL. IT WILL TOPSTITCH THE POTHOLDER/MUGRUG(PART 2). YOU CAN ALSO DO THIS ON A SEWING MACHINE IF YOU PREFER. STITCH THE DIE LINE ON A NEW PIECE OF MEDIUM WEIGHT TEAR AWAY STABILIZER



PLACE THE POTHOLDER/ MUGRUG SO IT TOUCHES THE DIE LINE



TAPE IT ALL THE WAY AROUND AS YOU ALIGN IT TO THE DIE LINE.

IN THE HOOP PUMPKIN POT HOLDER



MAKE SURE THE TWILL TAPE LOOP IS FOLDED OUT AND TAPE IT SO IT DOESN'T GET CAUGHT IN THE TOPSTITCH. YOU CAN FOLD AND TAPE THE WINGS ACROSS THE BODY OR LEAVE THEM FOLDED OUTWARD.



I LEFT MY WINGS OUTWARD. STITCH THE TOPSTITCHING. AT THE END I DECIDED TO SECURE THEM WITH DOUBLE SIDED FUSIBLE SEAM TAPE.



PEEL THE OWL POTHOLDER/MUG RUG UP FROM THE STABILIZER.



YOUR POTHOLDER IS NOW FINISHED! THE BACKSIDE HAS THE QUILTED FINGER PROTECTORS SO YOU CAN GRAB HOT PANS AND DISHES. YOU CAN SKIP THE QUILTED POCKETS AND MAKE IT JUST LIKE THE MUG RUG ON LARGER HOOPS IF YOU WANT TO USE IT AS A TRIVET.

THE MUG RUG WILL NOT HAVE THE FINGER PROTECTORS. IT SHOULD FIT A SMALL TEACUP-COFFEE MUG NICELY. ALL DONE!
